



What's the End of the Public Health Emergency for COVID-19?

The national COVID emergency ended in April 2023 and the public health emergency ended in May 2023. This means that programs and aid related to the COVID-19 pandemic are ending.



This affects migrant workers because vaccines, tests and treatment for COVID-19 may no longer be free.

How can we prepare ourselves?

- ✓ If you haven't been vaccinated or gotten an updated dose, **get vaccinated!**
- ✓ **Stay informed!**
- ✓ **Verify the information you have received** before sharing it to other people to prevent disinformation.
- ✓ **Check to see whether tests are offered for free.**
- ✓ **Protect against Covid-19 by:**
 - Washing your hands often
 - Getting vaccinated
 - Wearing a mask in crowded indoor spaces
 - Keeping a safe distance from others
- ✓ Take a COVID-19 test at home if you have [symptoms](#) or **were exposed**.
- ✓ **Know your rights** in relation to COVID-19 at work.
